




Progress Summary

In the year 2020, TMS completed its 13th year with the spirit of imparting quality education to the deprived children. Maximum number of students remained 180 for the 3rd utilizing consecutive year, full capacity. Due to Corona virus pandemic, the academic activities got immensely affected. For the first TMS experienced time, low attendance and few drop-outs. However, to meet the targets, TMS management worked hard to arrange alternate day classes with SOPs, video lectures and assignment based learning as alternative modes educate those who can't afford to have laptops, mobile phones or internet for Online Learning. Students were promoted in the Mid Term Exams on the basis of their assignments. Syllabus for the Final Term was reduced. Class VIII was reformed by the Principal to prepare them for Matriculation.

Meanwhile, to bear the monthly expenses, the number of sponsored students was raised to 110 from 65 by actively campaigning for "Sponsor a child's education".. "TMS Alumni Network" was made for all TMS graduates where we guide our exstudents regarding careers, keep their track record and help in any way possible. Need based scholarships are arranged for the deserving students and part-time work opportunities are also shared.

A TMS own "web-based school management system" is under developing stage whereas 80% of the task is completed to computerize the daily lesson plans. New equipments in the computer lab are also installed



Extra-Curricular Activities:

Parents & students were guided constantly about the necessary precautions and health safety. Masks & sanitizers were also distributed among the staff and students by Friends Café Calgary and Falah e Bashar groups. In summers, TMS students participated in a poster competition which was organized by the Voice News and won cash prizes. program for digital skills Α development was started by the name of APL (Accelerated Professional Learning) for senior students & Alumni to guide them for Freelancing. Majority of them are learning Graphic Designing and improving English Language.

Next Goals:

• Expansion of TMS is planned to benefit maximum illiterate children as well as providing start up/ entrepreneurship opportunities for young people.

• Second campus of TMS for the deserving children is planned and surveyed in Korangi. It will be started in 2021. Insha Allah!

• Renovation & paint in TMS Gulshan.

• Active fund raising campaign to find sponsors for all the children of both campuses.

• Computerizing all data of both campuses and finalizing online portal for the sponsors.

Progress Summary

Ziafat Food Charity's integration in PYO as a project added great value to the organization as well as helped the idea to serve as many helpless people as possible by providing basic necessities. Food is a primary need of all human beings and hunger is a devastating social problem. To fight hunger, Ziafat collects donation and cook fresh meals for the deserving people and provide them at random places across Karachi. Significant number of people got benefitted from this project as mentioned in the table under the leadership of Ms.Fauzia Imran. Due to Pandamic and shutdowns, unemployment rate also increased and many families got impacted by it one way or the other. Ziafat served iftaars and suhoor during Ramadan. Rashan drives were also initiated to provide relief.

A few unemployed yet deserving women got cooking opportunities under Ziafat in order to earn their living while staying at home.
